Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> March -

## Place

Easter Course 2012 will take place in **Ukraine**.

The exact location of the training centre will be released closer to the date.

## Participant age

Easter Course is aimed at 17-25 year olds. If you are outside this age range and would like to participate, contact us.

## Language

The official language of the training course is English, which all participants must be able to speak. Your English does not have to be perfect, but you should be able to have a normal conversation.

## Price

Registration fee is 150 euros (plus your own travel expenses).

The fee includes accommodation, food, program, local travel to the training centre, a day out and training materials.

European Fellowship will adapt the registration fee according to the participants' country of origin; check this from your own organisation.

## Date

You should arrive on Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> March and depart on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> April.

## Information pack

After you sign up, you will receive an info pack with practical information about 2 weeks before the course starts.

## Registration deadline

All registrations must be received by the European Fellowship Training Facilitator no later than 25<sup>th</sup> February 2012

Every year the Easter Course focuses on a theme, and this year that is about the balance of the freedom of speech against hate speech. Should hate speech be illegal? How does this affect youth organisations?
