Monday

Halloween: Halloween is also known as All Hallows Eve, or All Saints Eve. It comes just before All Saints Day, which is a Christian celebration of life – remembering the holy people (hallows) who have brought light into the world. Pray for those throwing a light party, giving out tracts to trick or treaters, and helping people to focus on the light – and not the darkness – this All Hallows Eve.

Tuesday

GB Europe: Pray for good discussions and relationships at the upcoming Girls' Brigade Europe Executive Team meeting. The meeting will take place in Glasgow from 6-8 October.

Wednesday

International Day of the Girl: 11 October is the United Nation's International Day of the Girl. Pray for girls across the world, and for ongoing progress to improve the lives of the 1.1 billion girls in the world today.

Thursday

Meetings: Trustees from GB Ministries and the GB England & Wales Network Executive Committee will meet this month (on 16 and 21 October) to shape the strategy and vision of our movement. Thank God for the volunteers who set aside time to contribute to GB in this way, and for productive conversations during their time together.

Friday

New members: Pray for all of the girls, boys, young people and leaders who are new to GB this autumn term. Pray that they'd settle into their group, and that they'd learn about Jesus and discover life to the full!

Saturday

The Esther Collective Bristol: We've just launched details of our new Esther Collective initiative, coming to Bristol from February-June 2018. Pray for local women aged 18-30s to hear about this great opportunity to have fun and discover more about themselves and God alongside peers.

Sunday

#WeAreGB125: As GB's 125th year approaches, pray for all those putting together plans for events, celebrations and social action projects in 2018. Pray that we'd raise hope in lives and local communities across the country.
