Every week the gospel is shared through the ministries of GB.

Romans Ch.10:14-15 challenges us to share the news of Jesus and not be complacent that 'somebody else will do it' or 'somebody else will do it better'. Paul says 'But how can people call for help if they don't know who to trust? And how can they know who to trust if they haven't heard of the one who can be trusted? And how can they hear if nobody tells them? And how is anyone going to tell them, unless someone is sent to do it?'

- Every time a young person attends a GB meeting, or a GB festival or event, the gospel is shared
- Every time a parent feels welcomed when they drop their daughter off at GB the gospel is shared
- Every time a young person chooses to be a disciple of Jesus because of what they've heard and experienced through GB the gospel is shared.



THE HEART OF GB

We want even more children and young people to hear the transforming and enriching gospel message that's at the heart of what GB does. In fact we have a vision that in 2013 GB will be enabling 120,000 children and young people to connect with the gospel message. 120,000 is a huge challenge but we believe it's God's challenge to us.

We're asking all GB leaders, friends and prayer partners connected to GB to help make this vision a reality:

- GB is massively supported by prayer. Around 125 people are currently part of Scaffold – GB's prayer network and receive the monthly Scaffold bookmark with prayer requests
- GB is also supported by financial gifts, which enable even more children and young people to hear the gospel.

£25 will help GB provide opportunities such as GB's Establish weekend for young people, aged 14-25, to explore what it means to be a follower of Jesus.
